EQUESTRIAN ARTS Radio Show

While waiting for the trails to dry out, a useful winter activity for horse lovers would be to listen to the Equestrian Arts radio show on Sonora's local community radio station KAAD-LP 103.5.


The show's host, Earlene Smith, has recorded over 150 well-researched, educational and interesting episodes. Subjects range from the history of the horse, to breeding and reproduction, health care, riding and training and even horses in art.

Some of the shows feature interviews with specialists such as a saddle maker, the Back Country Horsemen, and Cowboy 911, a mobile equine rescue organization. Earlene has six decades of personal experience and stories. Along with running the Peppermint Creek Carriage business for 30 years, she has bred, raised and trained her own horses, taken long family pack trips in the Sierras, and even worked as a veterinarian technician.


