Jack Brooks Horse Camp July 31 to August 9

Jack brooks horse camp event is coming up end of month July 31! Contact Diana Moreci (209-533-8511) and let her know if you would like to attend any of the days and stay a few nights until the 9th! Not catered. Ride shady trails and admire the many redwood trees.

Cost is \$87 per night divided by people in attendance. The most you will pay is \$21 per night. Camp holds 10 people and horses so could be as low as \$8.70 per night!

Corrals are supplied, plenty to choose from, bring water buckets. Hoses are supplied; wash racks, wheelbarrows, shovels supplied. Temps expected 55-75; mornings cold and foggy may need a horse blanket.

Hot showers, flush toilets, refrigerators in storage shed, outdoor stainless kitchen, BBQ and table!

DIRECTIONS

Take 92 over the San Mateo bridge continue towards half Moon Bay until you get to skyline turn left on skyline. Stay on skyline approximately 12 miles until you get to Highway 84 at Alice's restaurant. Turn right on 84. Continue on 84 towards the ocean for approximately 6 miles. Turn left on Pescadero Creek Road continue about 1 mile Road will "Y" take the hard right up the hill pass the Sam McDonald park ranger station and continue on another 2 to 3 miles. A left turn will be Ridge fire Road will be a dirt road blocked by a metal



pipe gate with a painted clock on the front. Entry is from top of the hour until 20 minutes after the drive from there is 10 minutes to the horse camp.
