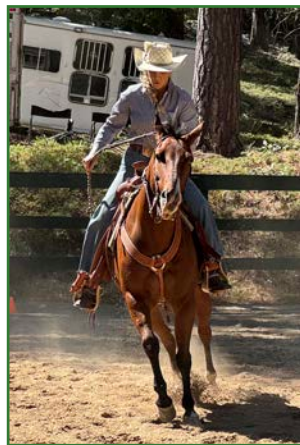
By the way, Chuck was the person who negotiated with the Forest Service (for \$1.00) to get the Center Camp lease for our club.
